## **Abstract**

Software categories include: word processors; reference managers; PDF readers; project planning and mind mapping; backup; file transfer; time tracking and invoicing; speech recognition and transcription; medical dictionaries, grammar and spell-checker; rest break; imaging; and anti-virus and internet security.
